

Dress Code

This information is for parents of students attending Toobanna State School. This policy has been endorsed by the P & C Association.

Students are expected to wear the school uniform every day, on excursions and when representing the school at official functions.

The school uniform consists of:

- a blue and a white "Toobanna" shirt,
- a blue broad brimmed "Toobanna" hat,
- royal blue shorts, trousers, tracksuit pants, skorts or skirt, and
- white socks and enclosed shoes.

Blue shirts are to be worn daily. White shirts are to be worn on special occasions as advised by the school.

Hats are to be worn at all times when outside. Shoes are to be worn at all times except where exemption is granted by the Principal in special circumstances, such as athletics practice.

The "Toobanna" hats and shirts may be purchased through the Parents and Citizens Association.

Inappropriate Dress

The following are some examples of inappropriate clothing for school.

- Singlet type tops
- Clothing with offensive or suggestive logos/slogans
- Overly short or tight shorts/skirts
- Exposed midriff
- Decorative jewellery
- Make-up/nail polish/false nails
- Any item/s that are deemed to be unsafe
