This funding will be used to


- Increase the percentage of students in Prep to year 6 achieving a 'C' standard or above in English from 80% in 2016 to 100% in 2017.
- Increase the percentage of Prep to year 3 students achieving NQ regional reading benchmarks from 40% in 2016 to 80% in 2017.

- Provide professional development and coaching to deepen teachers' understandings of the Australian Curriculum: English learning area and provide targeted and scaffolded instruction to secure highly effective first teaching of essential English concepts and skills in every classroom.
- Provide professional development and coaching to embed consistent teaching practises with respect to Early Years Reading.
- Implement the Instructional Coaching Cycle to build teacher capacity and develop a collaborative approach in every classroom.

- Employing an additional teacher to work in the early years classroom to develop early literacy skills -
- Providing professional development for all classroom staff relating to embed a consistent approach to Early Years Reading and developing the use of Collaborative Inquiry Cycles
