- Use the inquiry cycle model to develop personalised teaching and learning plans for every student. (State School Strategic Plan 2020-2024)
- Continue to trial and embed the Toobana State School Prep to Year 6 curriculum plan, moderation plan, pedagogical framework and whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning. (The Australian Curriculum Version 8)
- Collaborate to identify the targeted writing and reading demands of each learning area unit/assessment.
- Use the Australian Curriculum, Literacy Continuum - Reading Comprehension and Aspects of Writing to inform next steps/strategies. (Literacy Continuum)
